SAWLOG QUALITY SPECIFICATIONS

LENGTH: Sawlogs must be 100" long but no more than 106"

BUTT DIAMETER: A minimum of 6" on butt of log. There is no maximum. All wood must be sound on butt.

FLARE BUTT: Butt logs have to be cut above root to minimize flare butt effect.

LIMB: All limbs have to be removed and cut flush with the hole of the log.

FORK: Logs containing forks will be culled.

DEFECT: Loads containing defect of the following list will receive a deduction.

black heart (during winter operations)

Heart rot

Split

Crook

Ant hole

Dry wood

SWEEP Logs with more than 3" sweep will be culled.

TOP: All logs must have a minimum 4.5" top.

Unloading is available 6:30am to 4pm Monday thru Thursday and 6:30am to 11:30am on Friday.
